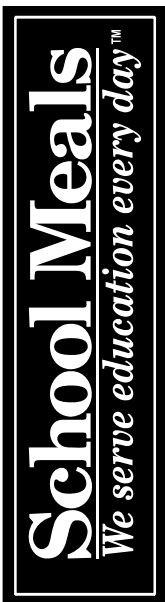

We want to make sure all students are monitored by staff, so help us keep them safe by not dropping them off at school too early. **Also, we cannot accept transportation changes over the phone. For student's safety, we will only accept any changes in writing or in person. We cannot verify who might be calling, so to protect our students, we will not accept bus changes over the phone.**
- In case of a weather emergency, we want to keep you fully informed of school closings, cancellations, and delays. Should school be closed or delayed due to inclement weather, an official notice will be posted on the school division's home page - www.vbschools.com - along with notification to local television and radio stations. If you do not have access to our Web site, you may call the 24-hr Beach-Line at 427-8000 and enter code #856 for the most current information. The new ALERTNow phone notification system will also be used to call all of our families in the event of a weather closing. Make sure the school has accurate phone numbers so you can be contacted in the event of school closing.
